CHESA Fellow Nathan Brand awarded GloCal Fellowship

Congratulations to Dr. Nathan Brand, 2021-2022 CHESA Fellow who was recently awarded a GloCal Health Fellowship from the University of California Global Health Institute to conduct research into the surgical oncology capacity of Tanzania. Nathan will work with Dr. Ozgediz, Director of CHESA, and Dr. Akoko, senior lecturer at Muhimbili University for Health and Allied Sciences to assess the surgical oncology case volume at the 5 largest public referral hospitals in the country. This project will create important baseline data into the current capacity in the country and will help identify high volume centers that may be leveraged in the future to train additional Tanzanian surgical oncologists.
